# Chapter 1

## Introduction

### 1.1 Introduction

This report provides an overview of the *2002-2003 American Academy of Religion Survey of Graduate Programs in Religion and Theology*, examining each variable in the main questionnaire by institution type.

There is one table for each variable. Tables appear in questionnaire order. For nominal and ordinal-level variables, cells indicate the *percentage of total respondents*; actual number of respondents appears along the marginals. For scalar-level variables, the mean and median are presented, along with the sample size.

### 1.2 Errata

Note that the table summarizing "Total funds allocated by institution to department" has a number of formatting flaws in it. This is the result of a programming bug that I have not been able to resolve as of this writing. Below is a corrected version of this table. Please note that, unlike the other tables in this report, the below version has the institution types along the x-axis. The below table was generated on 2003-Sep-21, 19:53:
